INTRODUCTION

LEADER: We are today on the 11th day of Christmas. The Lord made known himself and revealed his humble glory as the Prince of Peace to the shepherds of the land. We also know of the Magi who made the long and difficult journey to Bethlehem to pay homage to a newborn Jewish child.

We shall be celebrating the feast of the epiphany on Sunday. For us it is another opportunity to reflect on the true meaning of the Birth of Christ - God Incarnate - and how he is manifested in our lives.

EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT (Silence for at least 2 mins)

SCRIPTURE READING: Matthew 2:1-2, 9-11 (Silence 5 mins)

REFLECTION:

1. The Magi cared to understand and appreciate the message of the child in swaddling clothes – the Emmanuel.

Have we made an effort like the Magi to be present at the manger with things more valuable - namely, time, commitment and talents.

2. Spiritual gifts abound in our life. Are we willing to share them with others and manifest Jesus to others?

LEADER: The three wise men were the first non-Jews to whom was revealed the Saviour of the world - opening the Door of salvation to all who come to believe in Christ with the light of a determined faith.

4. That Christ may be made manifest - as we comfort those in physical and mental pain as well as those who are burdened by doubt and insecurity. For this we pray,

LEADER: Almighty and ever generous Father, we thank You for choosing us to manifest Your love and mercy. Continue to manifest the presence of Your Son to us and grant us the courage to submit willingly to Your plans. We make this prayer through Christ our Lord. Amen.
