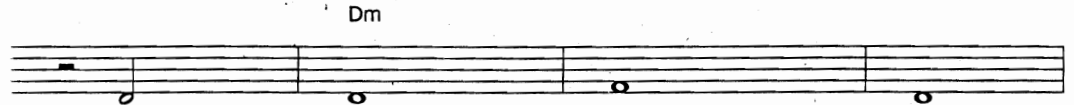

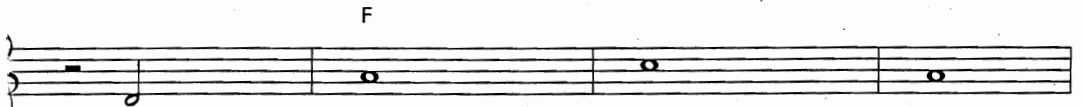
What mar-vels the Lord worked for us! In - deed we were glad.



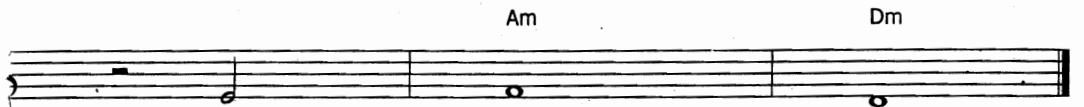
1. When the	Lord delivered	Zion from	bondage,
