Opening Prayer:

SCRIPTURE READING: Phillipians 3:10-11 To be proclaimed from the Bible [Silence] 5 mins

Reflection: [Leader] Suffering is hard. Let us ask the Lord to help us realize that He is at work in us. It takes eyes opened by the spirit to see that God uses our suffering to conform us to the image of CHRIST. Holding our identity with Christ more dearly than our personal things in life will bring more closeness and intimacy with our Lord. We have to open ourselves and bring about changes that will be permanent and spiritually renewing for ourselves and others. Resist in order to gain and treasure Christ above all things. . "Put on new self and render our hearts".

[Leader]* Quieten yourselfReflect prayerfully [on each sentence] At each point kindly keep a minute silence for reflection.

- Have I truly been the person God has `called me to be?
- Have I spent one on one time and grown closer to Jesus?
- What could I have done better to grow and deepen my relationship with my Lord?
- How might I do things differently in the future to help that relationship deepen?
- Have I treated others the way I should have been treated? Am I Happy?
- Am I ready to share, to return, to discover the fulfillment of my Christian beginnings through generous, loving and humble service.

Hymn:- Let the Lord have his way [Joyful Celebration no. 241]

[Leader]:-As Christians our focus ought to be purely on Christ. We need to die to the world of sin and temptation, so we can be fully transformed. Faith alone saves, and fellowship with Christ is all that highly matters. We ought to look forward to an eternity with our dear Lord. [Silence]

- 3. For all our parish members: be inspired to change the way we live. Work through us as we try to bring about change in our own lives and throughout the world; we pray to the Lord.... [R]
- 4. For all of us gathered here: that weovercome our inner conflict, be aware of the poor and homeless and be lead towards healing and building broken relationships; we pray to the Lord...[R]
- 5. We also pray for the forth coming elections to be held in our country; we pray to the Lord
- 6. Pause to pray for personal needs.....we pray to the Lord...[R]

FINAL PRAYER: Where your love resides, there is wholeness, where your peace inhabits, there is harmony, where your spirit lives, there is freedom. Infuse our lives with all that is good and pure and holy. We come to you as people in need of assurance, forgiveness and healing. Enfold us in your arms, bind us together, one people, one body and help us hear your voice. We pray for confidence to share and proclaim your word and enable us to know you more. Bless us in the understanding of your word. You are everything we desire, the everything we do not deserve. We pray that you grant us wisdom, knowledge, fullness of

grace and your peace that overcomes our pride. May our hearts receive, our mouths proclaim and our hands prepare for service. Take our mustard seed of faith and let it grow, take root and blossom in our hearts and lives. Raise us to new life and new ways of service. Amen.
