FIRST READING: Acts 1:1-11

SECOND READING: Ephesians 1:17-23

GOSPEL: Matthew 28:16-20

REFLECTION:

Many of us live with a mistaken belief that the ascension pertains only to Jesus. In the Roman Missal, the Preface I of the Ascension tells us "Jesus ascended into heaven not to distance himself from our lowly state, but that we his members, might be confident of following where he, our head and founder has gone before".

Jesus tells his disciples to go to Galilee where he had inaugurated his saving mission. The disciples begin to do what Jesus did. This time the mission is not bound by geographical limits but to "all nations" and "till the end of the age". Jesus commissions not only his first disciples but all those who follow him as his disciples. Are we ready to take up the mission of Jesus?

The first reading tells us about imploring God to send his Spirit and witnessing that will be the essence of the Church. In today's enthronement Psalm, the Israelites celebrated God's ascendancy over all heaven and earth. Today we use this psalm to proclaim that Christ has been given "all power in heaven and earth". He is able to be present with his disciples everywhere and in every age. We celebrate Christ's reign, even though we do not know the time when the kingdom will be fully manifest. We look forward to that day even as the second reading reminds us of the "hope that we are called to in Christ". How can our lives be one of sacrifice and service for others? By our witness can others be drawn to Christ?

PRAYER OF THE FAITHFUL

Leader: Jesus assures us, "I am with you always, until the end of the age'. Let us confidently bring our prayers before the Lord.

Leader: Heavenly Father, your Son Jesus, ascended into heaven to sit at your right hand. Hear the prayers that we offer you and help all of us to know your love. We ask this through Christ our Lord, Amen.

Let us together at the Saviour's command and formed by Divine teaching, dare to say: (All say the Lord's Prayer together) Our Father, ...
