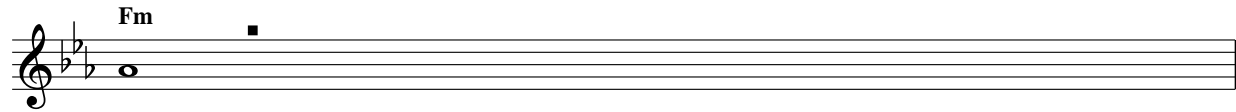

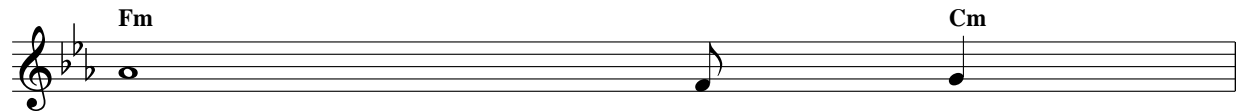
O that to-day you would lis-ten to his voice! Har-den not your hearts.



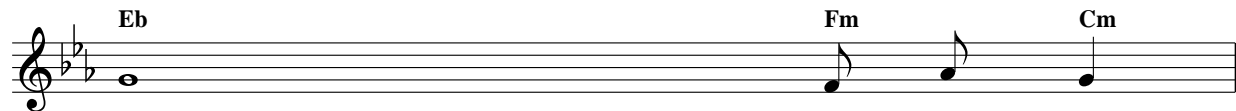
1. Come, let us ring out our joy to the Lord;

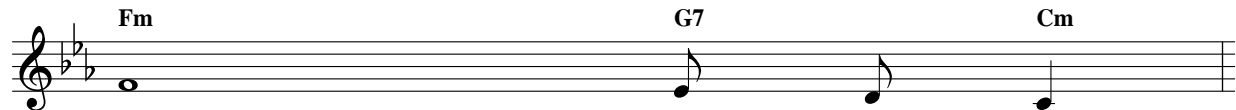
