

FIRST FRIDAY HOLY HALF HOUR – MARCH 2021

Theme: In honour of St. Joseph

INTRODUCTION:

St. Joseph has been declared Patron of the Universal Church by Pope Pius IX in 1870 and Pope John XXIII inserted his name in the Canon of the Mass. On 8th December 2020, Pope Francis gives us an Apostolic Letter: "With a Father's Heart".

EXPOSITION OF THE BL. SACRAMENT: *Hymn*: Father we adore you or any suitable hymn

We pause for a moment of *silence* to make a personal act of faith in the Real Presence of Jesus on our altar, and to praise and worship Our Lord.

<u>All:</u> O Sacrament most Holy, O Sacrament divine, all praise and thanksgiving be every moment Thine. Glory be...

<u>Leader:</u> Lord Jesus we come to you this evening on the First Friday of the month of March to spend time with you. We want to begin by seeking your pardon for the times we have forgotten you and even offended you, [in silence seek the Lord's pardon]

We have so much to thank you for [in silence let us bring to the Lord our personal thanksgiving]

We want to talk to you from our hearts and to listen to what you have to say to us. Let your Holy Spirit open our hearts and minds to put away all distractions and focus our attention on you alone. During this month dedicated to your foster father St. Joseph, we want to reflect on and model our lives on the example he has left us, as spelt out in the Letter of Pope Francis. [silence]

SCRIPTURE: We shall now listen to a reading from the Holy Bible: **Heb.11:1-12**

HYMN: [as response to the reading]

REFLECTION: [from John Paul II's Discourse on 19 March 1982] The Church lives on the heritage of Abraham's faith. The Church links its beginning also with the faith of Joseph of Nazareth. What emanates from his whole figure is faith, the true heritage of Abraham's faith. Joseph is a "just man" because he totally "lives by faith". Sacred Scripture does not record even one word spoken by Joseph, the carpenter of Nazareth. And yet, even without words. He shows the depth of his faith and greatness.

Above all he listens to the word of the Living God in silence. Therefore Joseph becomes truly a marvellous witness of the Divine Mystery. Looking with veneration and love at the figure of Joseph we must renew our own faith. Do we know how to listen to the word of God? Do we know how to absorb it into the depths of our human being? Do we welcome this word in the silence of interior readiness as Joseph of Nazareth?

[silence] We shall contemplate the figure of Joseph, in the presence of Jesus his foster son.

INTERCESSIONS:

Leader: We honour today, the wise and gentle figure of Joseph of Nazareth. His appearance in the history of salvation marks the moment in which God fulfils the ancient promises, with the incarnation of Christ. Through him we bring our intercessions to the Lord.

Response: FAITHFUL AND MERCIFUL GOD, HEAR US.

- 3. That all parents, through the assiduous meditation on the word of God and through common prayer may nourish their faith in God, who renews in the family, the marvels of his salvation. Let us pray to the Lord...
- 4. That workers all over the world, following the example of St. Joseph may rediscover the dignity of their vocation, and promote values of justice and peace. Let us pray to the Lord
- 5. That God's loving providence may extend in a special way over all who are deprived of their freedom, over the migrants and refugees, and over those who suffer persecution for their faith. Let us pray to the Lord...
- Leader: O God in the person of St. Joseph, you have given to your Church a sign of our Fatherhood. Watch over your children so that, amidst the joys and sorrows of life, they may always recognize your holy will and cooperate in the work of redemption. Through Christ our Lord...
