INTRODUCTION:

PRAYER OF THE FAITHFUL:

CEL: Filled with the Holy Spirit, the very breath of our risen and glorified Lord, let us pray to God for the needs of the whole human family. Our response is:

- 1. We pray for Pope Francis and all the leaders of the Church; that empowered by the Spirit they may bear joyful witness to the goodness of God... we pray to the Lord...
- 2. We pray for all who wield political authority in the world; that they will use that power to promote justice, peace and unity in the world, especially in these times of insecurity and fear... we pray to the Lord...
- 3. We pray for every baptized Christian; that we may develop more fully our response to all the gifts which the Spirit bestows for the service of the Body of Christ... we pray to the Lord...
- 4. We pray for a sprit-filled renewal of the face of the earth; where we may experience healing of body and spirit, where the vulnerable and the disturbed may be comforted, the hungry and thirsty may be satisfied and strangers welcomed with generosity... we pray to the Lord...
- 5. We pray for an end to violence and war in Gaza, Palestine and Israel; that the multireligious and multi-cultural identity of the Holy City be respected and that peace and fraternity prevail... we pray to the Lord...

6. We bow our heads and remember in silence our own personal intentions and the intentions of those who have asked for our prayers... (*pause for 7 seconds*) ... we pray to the Lord...

CEL: Heavenly Father, we rejoice in the gift of your Spirit which bears witness to your love and mercy. We thank you for listening to our prayers which we make through Christ our Lord. Amen.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF FROM THE CORONA VIRUS:
