- 5. That all those who are selflessly working during the pandemic may be protected from all harm... Let us pray to the Lord...
- 6. That the Lord may listen to the prayers we make, especially for a peaceful solution to the crisis in Afghanistan ... (pause for 7 secs)...Let us pray to the Lord...

**CELEBRANT:** God our Loving Father, we thank you for turning your eyes to the just and your ears to our appeals which we make with faith in You and in Your Son Jesus who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God forever and ever. Amen.
