

28 November 2021 FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT



INTRODUCTION:

At Advent we prepare for the coming of Christ at Christmas, but it also reminds us of the coming of Christ again. Advent tells us that we Christians must bring God's reign in our own lives in such a way that we are salt in this sorry society and bring about change which makes a real difference. We must not become fatigued, we prepare inwardly and spiritually, but if that means anything it is demonstrated visibly in our changed lives. This Advent we are challenged not to blame others, but instead to recognise that the change must come from us as we live the new lives of the Kingdom.
