

SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT 5th December 2021



INTRODUCTION:

Baruch recalls the prophecy of Isaiah to Jerusalem at the end of their Babylonian exile. He invites them to put away the garments of sorrow and affliction and be clothed in robes of righteousness. In the same way John the Baptist exhorts his community and all of us, to be ready for the coming of Jesus. In this Advent season, we shall have to fill up the valleys of our lives with virtues and level the mountains of our pride and sinfulness, to prepare the way.

Celebrant: We shall ask the Lord to assist us in our preparation for the coming of the Messiah.

- 3. That all those who have abandoned God and religion, being blinded by false values of this world, may be helped to find their way back to Jesus, who alone can bring them true joy and peace. We pray to the Lord... **R/-**
- 4. That the Lord Jesus may reach out to each of our school and college going youngsters as they return to the serious task of their education after the disturbance of the Covid 19 pandemic, we pray to the Lord... **R/-**
- 5. We bring to Jesus our personal needs and intentions [pause] we pray to the Lord... R/-

Celebrant: Heavenly Father listen to the prayers your children bring to you with confidence, and grant what we need, through Christ Our Lord. Amen
