PRAYERS OF THE FAITHFUL:

CELEBRANT: We seek the generous love of God who comforts us in our troubles and who listens to the needs of our hearts as we pray: **GRACIOUS LORD. HEAR OUR PRAYER**

6. For the needs we offer to the Lord with faith; that we may enjoy the generosity of His blessings... (Pause for 7 seconds)... we pray to the Lord...
