### PRAYERS OF THE FAITHFUL:

**CELEBRANT:** Let us surrender our needs to God who provides for the poor, the orphans, the widows and all who believe in His merciful love.

4. For our children and youth; that they may share the abundance of the blessings they have received, through the service they render in Church and in society with a spirit of gratitude to God who provides all our needs... we pray to the Lord...
5. For an adequate monsoon; that we may enjoy God's showers of blessings and be kept safe from the irregularities of the weather... we pray to the Lord...
6. For the prayers we make with faith in God; that we may enjoy the generosity of His grace... *(pause for 7 seconds)*... we pray to the Lord...
