

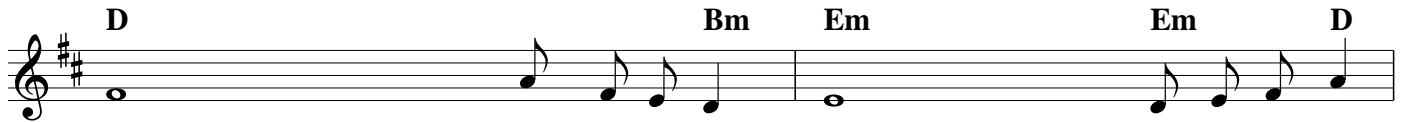

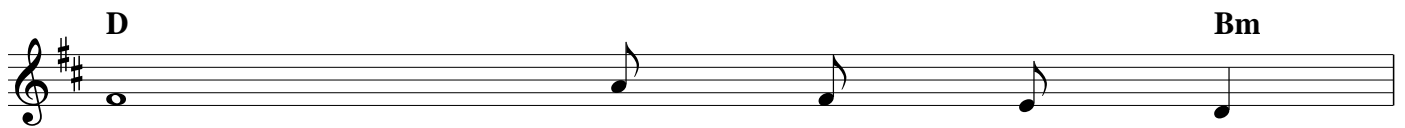

From the place where he dwells he ga - zes on all the dwel - lers on the earth.

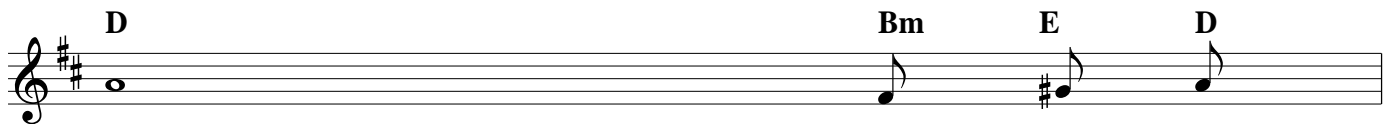

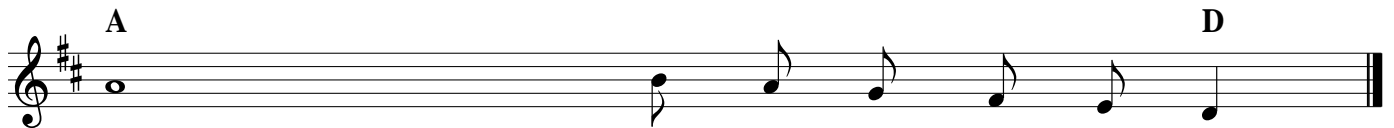
