CHRISTMAS NOVENA



INTRODUCTION: Dear friends, on this seventh day of the Novena in preparation for Christmas, we ask ourselves: Am I deeply longing for Jesus to come into my life or is my deep-seated longing for someone or something else in life?

SCRIPTURE: Lk 7: 18-23 (Are you the one who is to come or are we to expect another?)

REFLECTION: The question of John to Jesus reflects a common human experience; seeking confirmation and reassurance in the face of challenges or unanswered prayers. Jesus answered John, but not with a declaration but a picture of a world in which God's spirit is powerfully at work— the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have good news brought to them. This challenges us to look for signs of God's presence and work in our own lives.

O ADVENT ANTIPHONS: O come, desire of nations, bind in one the hearts of all humankind; bid now our sad divisions cease, and be yourself our King of peace. Amen

INTERCESSIONS: Response: Come Lord Jesus; come as the desire of our hearts!

Lord, help us to set our hearts where we will find true fulfilment and not betrayal. R/-

Strengthen and sustain our faith in the midst of uncertainty and doubt; vindicate the hope which we place in you. **R/-**

Lord, upon the technological advancement and complexities of human thoughts and desires; let Your coming shed its own light. **R/-**

Lord God, teach us to use our gifts for others and to fulfil the purpose you have for each of your children. **R/-**
