



24 DECEMBER CHRISTMAS NOVENA

INTRODUCTION: Dear friends, on this last day of the Novena in preparation for Christmas, we turn our gaze of faith towards Bethlehem with the entire Church. May the song of angels enchant our hearts again and draw us to Christ Child, our Emmanuel.

Reveal to us the mystery of your life, and then send us forth to reveal your Word to the furthest ends of the earth.
