

26 November 2023 SOLEMNITY OF CHRIST THE UNIVERSAL KING - Adoration

HYMN: No. 123. – Father we love you, we worship and adore you - (Joyful Celebration Hymnal)

(Pause... for Moments of Silent and Personal Adoration before the Eucharistic Lord)

INTRODUCTION: I will give thanks to you, LORD, with all my heart; I will tell of all your wonderful deeds. I will be glad and rejoice in you. (Ps. 9:1-2) My heart is filled with adoration, when I lift my eyes to you. For you are the Lord of all creation, you make all things new. I will sing the praises of your name. My Lord and Creator, your goodness encourages me to converse with you. To converse with you, O Lord, is the delight of my heart. In you I find everything that my heart could desire. Here, your light illumines my mind, enabling it to know you more and more deeply. Lord, coming before you in the Bl. Sacrament today, we recall your divine kingship and majesty. O Jesus you established your kingdom not by military or political power but by shedding your precious blood on the cross. You alone are worthy to attain kingship, glory, honour and power. Together with the angels and saints we sing your praises.

HYMN: No. 159 – Hail, Redeemer, king divine! (*Joyful Celebration hymnal*)Or any other.

Prayer of St Padre Pio before the Bl. Sacrament

Heavenly Father, I thank you for loving me. I thank you for sending your Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, to the world to save and to set me free. I trust in your power and grace that sustain and restore me. Loving Father, touch me now with your healing hands, for I believe that your will is for me to be well in mind, body, soul and spirit. Cover me with the most precious blood of your Son, our Lord, Jesus Christ from the top of my head to the soles of my feet. Cast anything that should not be in me. Root out any unhealthy and abnormal cells. Open any blocked arteries or veins and rebuild and replenish any damaged areas. Remove all inflammation and cleanse any infection by the power of Jesus' precious blood. Let the fire of your healing love pass through my entire body to heal and make new any diseased areas so that my body will function the way you created it to function. Touch also my mind and my emotion, even the deepest recesses of my heart. Saturate my entire being with your presence, love, joy and peace and draw me ever closer to you

every moment of my life. And Father, fill me with your Holy Spirit and empower me to do your works; so that my life will bring glory and honour to your holy name. I ask this in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. **Amen.**

SCRIPTURE: Jn 18:33-38

REFLECTION:

"You say that I am a king. For this purpose I was born and for this purpose I have come into the world—to bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice."

What is the kingship of Jesus? Jesus emphatically says that he came into the world to bear witness to the truth, and he is the truth. What is the truth? Like Pilate we too ask this question today. Truth is God himself. The truth that I know is not absolute; it has always subjectivity to it, as I am not absolute. We cannot define God, so also we cannot define truth as we are limited human beings. Though truth is absolute our belief is relative. Our situations, experiences and our upbringing shape our beliefs and understanding of Truth. We need to search for the truth in our life; we are always seekers of truth and pilgrims on the way to the absolute truth God. No one can claim that I possess the truth, on this solemnity of Christ the King let us grow in our understanding of the truth and be witnesses of God's kingdom here on earth.

In Jesus Christ, the King of the Universe, the world is being made new. Today we are called to witness and proclaim that Jesus is the King of our lives. It is only by God's grace and mercy that we are here today. Never give up but hold on to Jesus' invitation to be with him always. Amen.
