Prayers of the Faithful

That the season of Christmas may be a time for peace, for cessation of violence, for healing of physical wounds and emotional scars as we welcome the birth of Jesus, the Prince of Peace... we pray... **R**/

That God may now listen to the prayers we make from the depth of our hearts... (*Pause for 7 secs*)... we pray to the Lord... **R**/

Celebrant: Heavenly Father, we thank You for listening to the prayers we make with faith in You and Your Son Jesus who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God forever and ever. Amen.
