# THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OFJESUS CHRIST - B



#### **INTRODUCTION:**

Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, also known as the Feast of Corpus Christi. This solemn day, the liturgy reminds us that we worship the Real Presence of Jesus Christ – Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity – in the Blessed Sacrament and by receiving His Body and Blood during the Holy Eucharist we become sharers of His divine life. St. Augustine said, "Believe what you see, see what you believe and become what you are: the Body of Christ." When we say "Amen", we are saying "Yes! I believe this is the Body and Blood of Christ and that I will be the Body of Christ to others."
