Celebrant:

The Gospel reveals Jesus' divine power over disease and death and reminds us that we follow a God who restores, and raises the dead to life again. In faith and hope, we pray:

For every lay member of the Church, that they may recognise their mission of proclaiming the Gospel in words and deeds wherever they are. We pray to the Lord. **R**/

For ourselves as a parish community, may we have the grace to know that God's love is manifest in the way we relate to others. We pray to the Lord **R**/

For the intentions we pray in the silence of our hearts (p-a-u-s-e). We pray to the Lord. R/

Celebrant: God of life, grant us the grace that we may walk in the light of Christ and not in the darkness of hatred and sin, so as to arise, live and love again. We ask this in Jesus' name. Amen.
