



## 04 AUGUST 2024 Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time –B (Vianney Sunday)



## Introduction:

In the Gospel, Jesus speaks of the Father who sends the Bread of Life from heaven to give life to the world. It is the Bread of the Life – the Eucharistic Lord – that sustains our faith, our vocations and our life in the Church and as one Body of Jesus Christ.
