(Light two PURPLE CANDLES, one PINK CANDLE and one white Candle- Candle of Love)

The Angel's Candle is the fourth candle on the Advent wreath and is lit on the Sunday before Christmas. The Purple candle also reminds us of Penance, prayer, and sacrifice: A time to reflect on one's life, make a confession, and prepare one's heart for Christ's coming

Scripture Reading: Luke 2:13-16– (Optional)

Reflect:

"Peace to People of good will" True peace comes to those who are in harmony with God and His purpose. It emphasizes the concept that peace is not just the absence of conflict but is tied to a relationship with God and a life lived in accordance with His principles.

Action Plan:

Offer a helping hand, spread joy and be the reason for someone's smile and peace today.

God almighty may the divine message of peace, which the Angels announced at the birth of your incarnate Son guide us through our tumultuous days bringing serenity and joy. Let your message of peace abide, in every heart, eternally. Amen.
