Introduction:

On this Second Sunday of Lent, we reflect on Jesus' transfiguration as we seek transformation in our own lives, guided by God's light and strengthened by His presence.

Readings:

First Reading: Gen 15: 5-12, 17-18
Responsorial Psalm: Ps 27: 1, 7-8b, 8c-9abc, 13-14
Second Reading: Phil 3: 17-4: 1 or Phil 3: 20 -4: 1
Gospel Reading: Lk 9: 28b - 36

Prayers of the Faithful:

Celebrant: We surrender our prayers to our transfigured Lord who is our light and our salvation.

Our response is: LORD, HEAR OUR PRAYER

That the Holy Father, the Bishops, Priests, Religious and the lay faithful may always proclaim the life-giving message of the Gospel in their words and actions as God's chosen ones we pray...
